## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act creating a commission to study eligible MassHealth transportation services.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Non-emergency transportation service providers, such as vans and limousine services, are
- 2 prohibited from transporting patients who have been discharged from hospital and rehab
- 3 facilities, even if non-emergency transport vehicles are entirely appropriate.
- 4 This bill creates a study commission to review the situation and make recommendations
- 5 which may offer a lower-cost transportation solution for MassHealth patients who have been
- 6 discharged and do not need emergency-equipped transport.
