AN ACT RELATIVE TO AN EMPLOYER'S FIRST REPORT OF INJURY NOTICES OF INSURED
EMPLOYEE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 Clause Twenty-sixth, paragraph (c) of section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out paragraph (c) lines 140 to 142 and inserting in place thereof the
3 following new paragraph:—

4 (c) personnel and medical files or information; the notice of injury furnished to the division of
5 administration, the employee and insurer by an employer as required by section 6 of chapter 152 of the General
6 Laws that contains the name and nature of the business of the employer, the name, age, sex and occupation of the
7 injured employee, and the date, nature, circumstances and cause of the injury and such additional infractions as the
8 division shall prescribe and said information shall also be exempt from the provisions of section 10 of chapter 66 of
9 the General Laws; also any other materials or date relating to a specifically named individual, the disclosure of
10 which may constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy;
