#### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act to recover stolen property.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the
- 2 following section:-
- 3 Section 71A. Articles deposited in pawn with a licensed pawnbroker or second hand
- 4 dealer that exceed market value shall be photographed and cataloged with a brief description of
- 5 the item including any identifying characteristics. The office of the attorney general shall collect
- 6 and maintain such information in an electronic database which shall be made available to law
- 7 enforcement agencies for the purpose of identifying and recovering stolen property. The office
- 8 of the attorney general shall promulgate rules and regulations to implement this section.
