Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (p) of section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as most recently

2 amended by section 41 of chapter 182 of the acts of 2008, is hereby further amended by striking

3 out, at the end of clause (3), the word "and".

4 SECTION 2. Said paragraph (p) of said section 6 of said chapter 64H, as so appearing, is hereby

5 further amended by adding at the end the following clause:- ; and (5) sales of all living trees

6 used in commercial and residential landscapes.
