## **HOUSE . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . No. 3019**

By Mr. Hunt of Boston, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3019) of Daniel J. Hunt, Daniel J. Ryan and Daniel Cullinane for legislation to require the installation of sideguards and blind spot mirrors on certain vehicles to protect pedestrians and cyclists. Transportation.

#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to the protection of pedestrians and cyclists.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting before the word "Dealer" the following
- 3 sentence: -
- 4 "Convex mirror", a mirror on the front of a vehicle which enables the operator to see all
- 5 points on an imaginary horizontal line which is 3 feet above the road and is 1 foot directly
- 6 forward from the midpoint of the front of the motor vehicle and extends the full width of the
- 7 motor vehicle.
- 8 SECTION 2: Said section 1 is hereby further amended by inserting after the phrase
- 9 "United States Department of Defense." the following sentence:-
- 10 "Lateral protective device", an apparatus installed between the front and rear wheels to
- 11 help prevent injuries to unprotected road users, particularly from falling underneath the vehicle.

SECTION 3. Section 7 of said chapter 90 so as appearing is hereby amended by inserting after the third paragraph the following paragraph:-

14 Except in the case of an ambulance, fire apparatus, low-speed vehicle, or tractor, every motor vehicle having a gross weight of more than 10,000 pounds, and every trailer having an 15 unladen weight of more than 10,000 pounds, and every semi-trailer unit having a gross weight of 16 more than 26,000 pounds, and every conventional cab configuration in which more than half of 17 18 the engine length is forward of the foremost point of the windshield base and the steering wheel hub is in the forward quarter of the vehicle length operated in or upon any way shall be equipped 19 with a lateral protective device and a convex mirror, as defined by section 1 of chapter 90 of the 20 21 General Laws. The registrar shall adopt standards and specifications for the size, design, and mounting of lateral protective devices and convex mirrors. The registrar may provide alternative 22 23 means of compliance with the convex mirror requirement, including cameras and infrared devices. The Registrar shall also determine a phased-in schedule for compliance with this 24 paragraph, provided, however, that such phase-in shall begin no later than July 1, 2016.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon passage, provided, however, that the deadlines for compliance with this paragraph shall be established pursuant to section 3.
