An Act extending pandemic-related relief for dining establishments.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to extend pandemic-related relief for dining establishments, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 15 of Chapter 42 of the Acts of 2022 is amended by striking out the  
2 words “April 1, 2023” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- "April 1, 2024"

3 SECTION 2. Section 19 of Chapter 42 of the Acts of 2022 is amended by striking out the  
4 words “April 1, 2023” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- “April 1, 2024”
