In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act eliminating the requirement for the geriatric authority to make payment to the town of Milford in lieu of taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 76 of the acts of 1982 is hereby amended by striking out section

2 10B and inserting in place thereof the following section:

3 10B. The town shall not assess any tax upon the geriatric authority or geriatric system or

4 part thereof, or upon the income therefrom.

5 SECTION 2. The town of Milford shall forgive any payments in lieu of tax due and

6 payable by the geriatric authority or geriatric system pursuant to chapter 76 of the acts of 1982,

7 which have not been paid as of the effective date of this act.

8 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
