## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to assaults upon sport officials.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 265 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 section 13D½ the following section: —
- 3 Section XX Whoever commits an assault upon a sports official within the confines or
- 4 immediate vicinity of the athletic facility at which the athletic contest in which said official
- 5 officiated shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than two and one-half years in a house
- 6 of correction or by a fine of not more than ten thousand dollars.
