## AN ACT TO DESIGNATE POLISH AMERICAN CONGRESS DAY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting after Section 15CCCCC, the following section:-
- 3 The Governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart October 30th as Polish American
- 4 Congress Day, in recognition of the capacity of the Polish American Congress established in 1944 to
- 5 represent the domestic and international concerns of Americans of Polish descent at both the state and
- 6 federal levels of government in the United States.
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
