In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act providing for a distinctive registration plate for firefighters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1 Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
- 2 the following paragraph:-

- 4 The registrar shall furnish, upon application, to owners of private passenger motor
- 5 vehicles who are members in good standing of a fire department within the Commonwealth of
- 6 the Massachusetts or to the surviving spouse of a firefighter killed in the line of duty, a
- 7 distinctive registration plate which shall display on their face a design indicating their status as
- 8 firefighters. No such plate shall be issued or renewed until proper certification has been made to
- 9 the registrar by the chief of the fire department in which the applicant serves. There shall be a

- 10 \$10 fee for the plate in addition to the established registration fee for passenger motor vehicles
- 11 which shall be transferred to the Massachusetts Firefighters Academy Trust Fund established
- 12 under section 165A of chapter 6.
