## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act prohibiting protesting on high speed roadways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding any special or general law, or rule or regulation to the contrary, Any
- 2 person who intentionally blocks or prevents access to a public roadway or highway, which legal
- 3 speed limit is 30 miles per hour or higher ,while protesting with the express purpose of
- 4 preventing passage of others shall be punished by imprisonment in state prison for not more than
- 5 10 years or by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars and imprisonment in jail or house of
- 6 correction for not more than two and one half years.
