2	Whereas, Thanksgiving Day is one of the most popular travel days in the United States,
3	Whereas, High volumes of traffic increase emissions and damage to the environment,
4	Whereas, Changes in traffic patterns lead to a higher probability of automobile accidents,
5	Whereas, Stopping to pay tolls increases the density of traffic on highways,

7	It is resolved that the Massachusetts Department of Transportation will conduct a study
