An Act to allow translators for driving tests.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the third sentence, the following sentence:-
- 3 To facilitate the examination of a non-english speaking applicant, the applicant may be
- 4 accompanied by an interpreter of his own choosing, whose credentials are deemed suitable to the
- 5 registrar, to assist in the oral and road portion of the driving test.
