Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 59 of the 1995 Transportation Bond Bill is hereby amended by increasing the
- 2 percentage of state participation for eligible projects and authorizing the Massachusetts
- 3 Department of Transportation Aviation Division to reimburse an airport sponsor for up to 95% of
- 4 the total project cost as adjusted for federal reimbursement, if any.
