An Act relative to expired licenses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 90 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition is
- 2 hereby amended by inserting after Section 10 the following section:-
- 3 Section 10A. "No person who is operating a motor vehicle on an expired license shall be
- 4 in violation of section 10 of this chapter, however, a person who operates a motor vehicle on an
- 5 expired license shall be responsible for a civil violation with a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00), if the
- 6 expiration is less than ninety days old, and one hundred dollars (\$100.00) if such expiration is
- 7 ninety days or greater."
