## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to antique motor vehicle inspections.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 7A of Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 adding at the end of the first paragraph the following:-
- The Registrar shall adopt rules and regulations to exempt antique automobiles that are 75
- 4 years old or older, whose owners are members of a recognized antique automobile club, from the
- 5 annual vehicle safety inspection program. Said antique automobiles shall be actively registered
- 6 with an antique or year of manufacture registration plate to qualify for this exemption. An
- 7 antique automobile exempt under this section that changes ownership shall be required to have a
- 8 vehicle safety inspection performed within seven days of being registered by the new owner.
