In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act requiring the hands-free use of mobile telephones while driving.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 13 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the word "mobile telephone" in line 6, and
- 3 inserting in place thereof the following:- hands-free mobile telephone.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 13B of said chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
- 5 inserting the following subsection:-
- $(a\frac{1}{2})$ No operator of a motor vehicle shall use a mobile telephone or mobile electronic
- 7 device, unless the telephone or device is being used as a hands-free mobile telephone.
