The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act designating January 30 of each year as Fred Korematsu Day of Civil Liberties and the Constitution in Massachusetts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by inserting after section
- 2 15MMMMMM, the following section:-
- 3 Section 15NNNNN. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart
- 4 January 30 of each year as Fred Korematsu Day of Civil Liberties and the Constitution, in
- 5 recognition of the birthday of Fred Korematsu and to educate about and honor the life of Fred
- 6 Korematsu, his perseverance, and his determination to advocate for the civil liberties of all
- 7 Americans, and recommending that the day be an opportunity for civic participation and
- 8 observed in an appropriate manner by the people.
