Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1: Section 6 of Chapter 118G of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding after paragraph (1), the following paragraph:
- 3 (m) Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, all insurance premium rates for
- 4 accident and sickness insurance and long term care insurance shall not increase more than 4 per
- 5 cent annually.
