## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to Route 90.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION XXXX. (a) The Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall conduct a 2 feasibility study relative to the establishment of an interchange on interstate highway route 90 3 between existing exits 8 and 9 located between the town of Sturbridge and the town of Palmer. 4 The study shall examine and evaluate the costs and economic opportunities related to 5 establishing the interchange including, but not limited to: (i) the projected capital costs; (ii) the 6 projected operating costs; (iii) the projected use levels; (iv) the environmental and community 7 impact estimates; (v) the availability of federal, state, local and private sector funding sources; 8 and (vi) the resulting economic, social and cultural benefits to the surrounding region and the 9 commonwealth.

(b) The department shall file a report of the results of its study with the clerks of the
senate and house of representatives, the chairs of the senate and house committees on ways and
