Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled

3 SECTION 1. Paragraph (a) of section 2F of chapter ninety of the General Laws is
4 hereby amended by striking out the number “1,500” in the second sentence; in the third sentence;
5 and in the fourth sentence and inserting in each place thereof the number: - 500.

6 SECTION 2. Paragraph (b) of section 2F of chapter ninety of the General Laws, is
7 hereby amended by striking out the number “3,000” in the first sentence and inserting in place
8 thereof the number: – 1000.
