An Act relative to sex offenders.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section 178K of chapter 6 of the General Laws,

2 as so amended by chapter 77 of the Acts of 2003, is hereby amended by inserting, in the fifth

3 sentence, after the word "Investigation." the following sentences:-

4 No sex offender designated as a level 2 or 3 offenders shall establish a home address or intended

5 home address or any other living accommodation within 500 feet of the property on which any

6 public or private school, licensed day care center, or any other child care facility is located. Nor

7 shall the offender accept employment within 500 feet of the property on which any public or

8 private school, licensed day care center, or any other child care facility is located.
