# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to littering out of motor vehicles.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

2 and inserting in place thereof the following:-

3 Section 22G. Whoever operates a motor vehicle on the ways of the Commonwealth shall 4 not dispose of any litter, trash or garbage from said motor vehicle on any public or private 5 property. Violators of this section shall be punished by a fine of fifty dollars. The registrar may, 6 after due hearing, suspend, for a period not exceeding seven days, the license or permit to 7 operate motor vehicles or the right of a person to operate motor vehicles in the Commonwealth 8 of any person who litters, or who knowingly permits, as the operator, occupants of said motor 9 vehicle to litter public or private property through the disposal of trash or garbage from said 10 motor vehicle.
