In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to Purple Heart registration plates.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1.	Section 2 of	Chapter 90	of the general	laws are hereby amend	led by

2 removing the sixteenth paragraph and inserting in its place the following:-

3 The registrar shall furnish to owners of private passenger motor vehicles who are 4 veterans as defined in said clause Forty-third of said section seven of said chapter four who have 5 been awarded the Order of the Purple Heart and upon evidence deemed satisfactory by the 6 registrar, distinctive registration plates bearing the image of a Purple Heart Medal for any private 7 passenger motor vehicle or motorcycle owned by such Purple Heart recipient. The first set of 8 such registration plates issued to an eligible veteran must be furnished at no charge. The registrar 9 may charge the established registration fee for private passenger motor vehicles or motorcycles 10 for each additional set of such registration plates or emblems. A surviving spouse of a deceased 11 recipient of the Purple Heart may elect to retain such distinctive registration plates for personal 12 use upon payment of the established registration fee for private passenger motor vehicles or

- 13 motorcycles and an additional annual twenty dollar fee until such time as such spouse remarries
- 14 or fails to renew or cancels such registration.
