**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act requiring hand sanitizer dispensers in schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of chapter 70B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following definition:

3 "Hand sanitizer dispenser", a wall-mounted receptacle that dispenses liquid chemical
4 germicide used for the purpose of cleaning hands and reducing the spread of germs.

5 Section 2. Section 3 of chapter 70B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
6 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 3(k), the following section:-

7 Section (k1/2). require that hand sanitizer dispensers be prominently mounted and
8 displayed in classrooms and near major entranceways of all public school facilities for the
9 purpose of reducing illness.
