- 7 SECTION 2. Said section 1 of said chapter 84, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by
- 8 adding the following sentence: Railroad crossings at grade with such highways and town ways
- 9 shall be kept in a reasonable state of repair at the expense of the owner of said railroad crossing.
