- the Commonwealth of Massachusetts believes that a convention called pursuant to
- 2 Article V of the United States Constitution should be convened to consider amendments to that
- 3 Constitution to limit the influence of money in our political system, among other reasonable
- 4 proposals; and
- Whereas, the Congress of the United States has failed to propose, pursuant to Article V of
- 6 the Constitution, amendments that would adequately address the concerns of Massachusetts;
- 7 Therefore, be it resolved, that the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, speaking through its
- 8 legislature, and pursuant to Article V of the United States Constitution, hereby petitions the
- 9 United States Congress to call a Convention for the purpose of proposing Amendments to the
- 10 Constitution of the United States of America:
- Be it further resolved that, and not intending to condition this petition, Massachusetts
- 12 requests that its specific concerns notwithstanding, Congress limit the agenda of the convention
- 13 to those matters enumerated by at least ten of the states calling for the convention;
- Be it finally resolved that, Massachusetts requests that Congress exclude from eligibility
- 15 as delegates to the convention any Member of Congress, or current candidate for Congress.
