An Act relative to headstones for deceased members of the Massachusetts National Guard.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 115 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after 2 section 9 the following section:-
- 3 SECTION 9A. The commission of veteran's service shall furnish upon request
- 4 headstones for deceased member of the Massachusetts National Guard who served 10 years or
- 5 more. Such headstones shall be similar to those furnished by the U.S. Department of Veterans
- 6 Affairs.
