The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Deborah Hawkins, an employee of the Office of the State Auditor.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the office of the state auditor, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the office of the state auditor
- 2 shall establish a sick leave bank for Deborah Hawkins, an employee of the office. Any employee
- 3 of the office may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick
- 4 leave bank for use by Deborah Hawkins. If Deborah Hawkins terminates employment with the
- 5 office or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall
- 6 be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for
- 7 absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave
- 8 bank as determined by the office.
