**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act designating the official seasoning of the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 2 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 official edition, is hereby
2 amended by inserting the following section:-

3 Section (x). “Bell’s Seasoning,” created by William G. Bell, a Boston inventor in 1867
4 and manufactured in East Weymouth Massachusetts, shall be the official seasoning of the
5 Commonwealth of Massachusetts
