Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (n) of section 5 of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as appearing

2 in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "instances", in line

3 58, the following words:-; provided, however, that a veteran shall not be charged any fee for any

4 examination provided by this chapter.

5 SECTION 2. Section 20 of said chapter 31, as so appearing, is hereby amended by 6 inserting after the word "four", in line 7, the following words:- ; provided, however, that a

7 veteran shall not be charged any fee for any examination provided by this chapter.
