## AN ACT RELATIVE TO JUNIOR OPERATORS LICENSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The 7<sup>th</sup> paragraph of section 8 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence and inserting in place thereof the  
3 following:-

4           The holder of a junior operator's license who is stopped by a police officer for a violation of  
5 sections 17, 17A or 18 and it is such operator's first offense shall be given a warning and informed by the  
6 police officer that a subsequent offense will result in the suspension of the license.
