The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to the Sex Offender Registry.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1: Section 178D of the Chapter 6 of the Massachusetts general laws is hereby amended
- 2 by striking after the number “1”, the following words “ or level 2” and is further amended by
- 3 adding after subsection (ii) of said section 178D the following words at the end thereof, “,
- 4 including institutions of higher learning.”

- 5 Section 2: Section 178J of the Chapter 6 of the Massachusetts general laws is hereby amended
- 6 by striking after the word “offender” the following words, “, If available”.
