**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act regulating lottery funding.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 35 of chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 17, the following paragraph:-

3 “Any city or town that has the ability to provide the sales of the Massachusetts State
4 Lottery games but does not provide opportunity for sales shall not receive funding from the fund
5 known as the State Lottery and Gaming Fund.”
