An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Lisa A. Sullivan, an employee of the Trial Court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2 Trial Court shall establish a sick leave bank for Lisa A. Sullivan, an employee of the Trial Court.  
3 Any employee of the Trial Court may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation  
4 days to the sick leave bank for the use by Lisa A. Sullivan. Whenever Lisa A. Sullivan  
5 terminates employment with said department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, the  
6 balance of the sick leave bank time shall be transferred to the trial court paid sick leave bank.  
7 Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that  
8 necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the Trial Court.
