**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act exempting Michele Moorhouse from the maximum age requirement for applying for civil service appointment as a police officer in the town of Ware.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other general or
2 special law or rule or regulation to the contrary regulating the maximum age of an applicant for
3 appointment as a police officer, Michele Moorhouse of the Town of Ware, shall be eligible to
4 have her name certified for original appointment to the position of Police Officer in the Town of
5 Ware notwithstanding her having reached the age of 32 before taking any civil service
6 examination in connection with that appointment. Michele Moorhouse shall be eligible for
7 appointment to the position of police officer in the Town of Ware provided that she meets all
8 other requirements for certification and appointment to this position.

9 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
