So much of the recommendations of the Department of the State Treasurer (House, No. 23) as relates to eligible prior service. Public Service.

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)

An Act relative to eligible prior service.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 126, after the words “rendered in each
3 group;” the following:- “provided, however, that classification of the eligible prior service
4 rendered by the member in each group shall be made by the retirement board from which the
5 member is retiring;”

6 SECTION 2. Said section 5 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby further
7 amended by inserting, in line 130, after the words “rendered in each group” the following:-
8 “provided, however, that classification of the eligible prior service rendered by the member in
9 each group shall be made by the retirement board from which the member is retiring”.
