## AN ACT RELATIVE TO LICENSE PLATES FOR CARSHARING VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding after section 32E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> the following section:-
- 2 Section 32E<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>: (a) As used in this section, “carsharing organization” means a corporation or cooperative
- 3 that owns a fleet of one or more cars, parked in common areas and retains a membership base that has
- 4 exclusive access to the fleet on a timed basis. The registrar of motor vehicles shall promulgate regulations
- 5 to further define “carsharing organization” as necessary.
- 6 (b) Vehicles in the fleet of a carsharing organization shall be permitted to bear residential license plates as
- 7 issued by the registrar of motor vehicles under Section 2 of Chapter 90.
