**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to a clean transportation future.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Section 2 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 402 after the words, “thereunder.” the
3 following:

4 On and after January 1, 2038, the registrar shall not accept an application for original
5 registration for any motor vehicle unless that vehicle is a zero emissions vehicle. For the
6 purposes of this section, “zero emissions vehicle” means a vehicle that produces zero exhaust
7 emissions of any criteria pollutant or precursor pollutant, or greenhouse gas, excluding emissions
8 from air conditioning systems, under any and all possible operating modes or conditions.
