## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to renewable energy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 183A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following new section:-
- 3 Section 23. Any owner of a unit which is detached and is a free standing unit, install a
- 4 solar energy system, as defined by section one-A of chapter forty-A, without seeking approval
- 5 from the managing agent or homeowners organization of unit owners. All costs associated with
- 6 the installation of a solar energy system shall be borne solely by the owner of the free standing
- 7 unit electing for such project.
