### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Susan Comeau an employee of Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Massachusetts
- 2 Rehabilitation Commission shall establish a sick leave bank for Susan Comeau, an employee of
- 3 the Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission. Any employee of the Massachusetts
- 4 Rehabilitation Commission may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days
- 5 to the sick leave bank for use by Susan Comeau. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for
- 6 absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave
- 7 bank as determined by the department. If Susan Comeau terminates employment with the
- 8 department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank
- 9 shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank.
