An Act relative to film tax credit transferability.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 584-585, the words “, any costs  
3 related to the transfer of tax credits”.

4           SECTION 2. Said section 6 of said chapter 62, as so appearing, is hereby further  
5 amended by striking out paragraph (5) of subsection (l).

6           SECTION 3. Section 38X of chapter 63, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking  
7 out, in lines 40-41, the words “, any costs related to the transfer of tax credits”.

8           SECTION 4. Said section 38X of said chapter 63, as so appearing, is hereby further  
9 amended by striking out subsection (e).
