## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to business transactions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 407 of the Act of 2022 is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 subsection (c) the following new subsection:-

- 3 (d) subsection (b) shall not apply to purchases from persons with a business registered
- 4 with the secretary of state that are regularly engaged in the business of manufacturing catalytic
- 5 converters or vehicles, or that are regularly engaged in the business of generating detached used
- 6 catalytic converters in the ordinary course of the seller's business. For these purchases the buyer
- 7 will be required to capture and retain the date, time, quantity of convertors and documentation of
- 8 being in the licensed business.
