**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to SMART Plan budgets.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 64 of chapter 29 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition,
2 is hereby further amended by inserting at the end thereof the following paragraph:-

3 “The state treasurer, on behalf of the deferred compensation program, may adopt annual
4 budgets and supplemental budgets as necessary. Said budgets may include salaries for treasury
5 employees tasked with working on and/or administering the deferred compensation program, and
6 said budgets may be funded from the administrative expense account of the deferred
7 compensation program. Any such treasury employee whose compensation is sourced from the
8 deferred compensation program shall be an “employee” as that term is defined in section 1 of
9 chapter 32 and shall be a member of the Massachusetts state employees’ retirement system.”
