**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act regarding Medicaid eligibility for seniors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 25 of chapter 118E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (5) the following:

3 (6) resources in an amount determined annually in accordance with 42 U.S.C. §1395w-
4 114(a)(3), the criteria used for a Medicare Part D low-income subsidy for individuals with
5 income up to 135 percent of the federal poverty level.

6 The division shall file for any necessary waiver, amend its state plan to the extent
7 required by law and promulgate regulations to implement said resource exemption.
