## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act requiring backup cameras on certain vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after section 7CC the following section:-
- 3 Section 7DD. A class 3 or above motor vehicle, trailer, semi-trailer or semi-trailer unit, as
- 4 classified by the Federal Highway Administration, with a gross vehicle weight rating of more
- 5 than 10,000 pounds that is owned or leased by the commonwealth or a city or town of the
- 6 commonwealth, shall be equipped with a backup camera. The registrar shall issue rules or
- 7 regulations relative to the requirements of this section.
