An Act relative to water treatment and wastewater treatment facilities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           As a matter of public safety, the Board of Examiners of Plumbers and Gasfitters will be  
2 authorized to oversee and set standards for piping work carried out in connection with systems of  
3 water treatment plants and systems, as well as piping work carried out in connection with waste  
4 water treatment plants and systems. All such work will be deemed the work of licensed  
5 plumbers, and will be inspected by the plumbing inspector of the authority having jurisdiction.
