An Act establishing a sick bank for Matthew Robitaille..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, or rule, or regulation to the contrary, the Bristol
- 2 county sheriff's office shall establish a sick leave bank for Matthew Robitaille, an employee of
- 3 the office, to allow him time to care for his children and injured wife. Any employee of the
- 4 Bristol county sheriff's office may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation
- 5 days to the sick leave bank for use by Matthew Robitaille. Whenever Matthew Robitaille
- 6 terminates employment with the Bristol county sheriff's office or requests to dissolve the sick
- 7 leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness
- 8 leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or
- 9 disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the Bristol
- 10 county sheriff's office.
