By Mr. Howitt of Seekonk, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3498) of Steven S. Howitt and Angelo L. D'Emilia relative to antique motor vehicles. Transportation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to antique motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7A of Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding at the end of
2 the first paragraph the following: -

3 “The Registrar shall adopt rules and regulations to exempt antique automobiles that are
4 50 years-old or older, whose owners are members of a recognized antique automobile club, from
5 the annual vehicle safety inspection program. Said antique automobiles shall be actively
6 registered with an antique or year of manufacture registration plate to qualify for this exemption.

7 An antique automobile exempt under this section that changes ownership shall be required to
8 have a vehicle safety inspection performed within seven days of being registered by the new
9 owner.”
