Kennedy (by vote of the town) for legislation to authorize a Parks and Recreation Department revolving fund in the town of Hanover. Municipalities and Regional Government. [Local Approval Received.]

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An act permitting the Town of Hanover to establish a Parks and Recreation Revolving Fund.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of clause (4) of the third paragraph of Section 53E1/2 of
- 2 Chapter forty-four of the General Laws, the Town of Hanover may establish a Revolving Fund
- 3 for the Parks and Recreation Department from which the town may expend an amount in excess
- 4 of one percent of the amount raised by taxation in the Town of Hanover in the most recent fiscal
- 5 year for which a tax rate has been certified, provided that said revolving fund complies in all
- 6 other respects with the provisions of Section 53E1/2 of Chapter forty-four.
  
- 7 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
